Accomplished performer and mentor Lloyd Van't Hoff opens the program with what is considered the greatest work composed for clarinet and piano with Brahms' second sonata followed by two of the most popular and extraordinary works for violin, clarinet and piano in a Selby & Friends first – after more than 30 years, we finally have an opportunity to program Kathy's childhood favourite, Béla Bartók! *Contrasts* is widely considered one of the seminal works for this instrumental combination and the composer's famous charming Romanian Dances rounds out a spectacular and virtuosic concert experience.

How to book a 2024 Subscription

1. Online

2024 Subscriptions will be handled by the Selby & Friends office with the exception of Melbourne (see below for details).

Melbourne Subscriptions at Melbourne Recital Centre

For Melbourne patrons, please use this link to purchase through the Melbourne Recital Centre. The venue is open seating for these concerts. Seating is limited so please act quickly to secure your seat. Phone the venue box office on (03) 9699 3333 should you require additional assistance.

2. Email/Mail

Subscriber Information + Priority Seating

Subscribers will continue to enjoy our exclusive substantial savings over single ticket prices in all venues. 2023 subscribers will also receive **priority first choice seating** and the option to retain or change their current seating locations in reserved seating venues. For this to occur, we must receive your subscription renewal by midnight on the **15 December 2023**. For current subscribers renewing during the Early Bird promotion, this will guarantee your seat preference and seat allocation in our more intimate venues.

We **strongly** encourage patrons to use our <u>online ticket order link</u> and <u>Buy Tickets</u> through our website as this takes patrons to a choice of purchasing subscriptions or single tickets in the venue of their choice and provides an immediate receipt for your records.

We have now moved to predominantly online and door ticket sales as our phone is monitored but we have irregular office hours. For those patrons wishing to email or mail in their subscription/order form, please fully complete and follow the instructions on the <u>Ticket Order Form</u> and send it us either by <u>email</u> or by mail.

Please note some venues may have capacity restrictions. Seating allocation for renewing subscribers will therefore be processed and allocated in order of receipt, so please book early to avoid any disappointment.

Patrons purchasing as a group larger than two people will be able to sit together in reserved seating venues. Please ensure you provide details for those with whom you wish to be seated to avoid any errors on our part. Please refer to the <u>Venue Information</u> page for seating layout and updated policies for your venue.

Contactless Ticketing

2024 will see Selby & Friends continue with our contactless ticketing method in applicable venues.

We will not be issuing paper tickets for our 2024 Season. We strongly encourage all patrons to use our online ticketing portal through the Selby & Friends website for applicable venues. This is a secure portal, easy to understand and navigate, which allows patrons to use a credit card. Selby & Friends also provides the option of purchase via Direct Deposit or EFT for applicable venues.

Tickets for 2024: After purchasing through our online portal, patrons will receive a receipt directly from our Selby & Friends account via email. If you do not have access to email and prefer to mail your order form to our office, S&F will mail your ticket entry document to your supplied address.

Confirmation of purchase and supply of your E-Ticket, either by email or mail, with all relevant seating information, will be sent to purchasers from Selby & Friends in early 2024 when the Priority Seating Subscriber Renewal period ends. This E-Ticket will serve as your concert entry ticket.

As you enter the concert venue, you can either present it in virtual form on your mobile device or bring a hard copy you have printed at home. You will also need to bring a form of identification

(please see further information below). There will be no traditional paper tickets sent to you by mail.

If you purchase for friends, please supply their details at the time of purchase so we can keep our files up to date on their seating as well as yours. However, as the Primary Purchaser, only your name will be on the E-Ticket sent to you.

ID at point of entry: Patrons are requested to bring a form of identification to the concert along with the E-Ticket from Selby & Friends to show at the entrance to the concert should our staff request it.

*If you are unable to bring a printout or the email on your device to the concert, please contact our office prior to your concert.

Additional Information

If you have misplaced your entry email confirmation, please contact our office during office hours. Ticket exchanges for concerts in other venues will require a new entry pass to be sent to patrons by email before your scheduled concert.
